


Reminder: Joint letter to Adm. Bono:

- Provide clear and uniform guidance about how to care for COVID patients (alternative care sites, specialized capacity, cohorting)







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Data collection and reporting

- Significant needs
 - PPE, Staffing, Testing, Funding
- LTC liability protection
 - Request to Governor's Office
- Operations during crisis
 - Example for the field
 - Conflicting guidance
 - Punitive regulatory approach

Short Term

- PPE and staff training
- Testing
- Staffing
- Alignment on data collection
- Funding

Long Term

- Preparing for fall surge
 - Health system wide needs
 - Liability protections
 - Funding
- State law waivers
- Alignment with federal waivers
- Single state agency in charge
