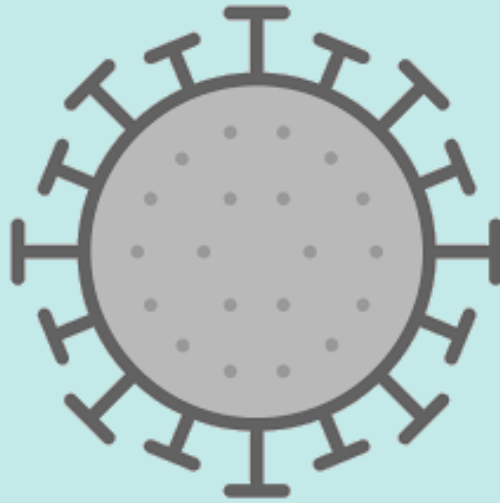



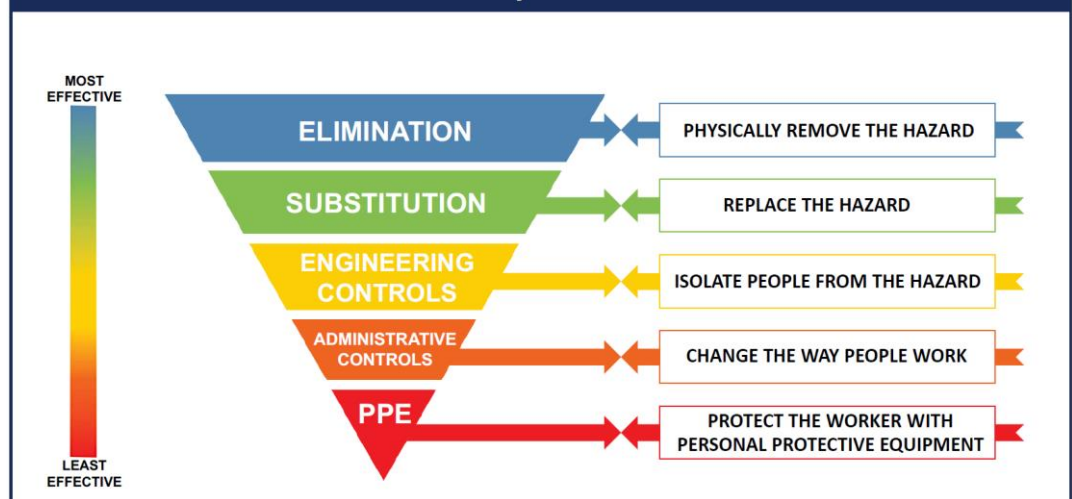
PPE: Surgical / Procedure Masks


